The Company is committed to maintaining accurate financial records and ensuring that all gifts, hospitality, expenses, and transactions are properly recorded and transparent.


Any breach of this policy may result in disciplinary action up to and including dismissal, termination of contracts, and possible criminal prosecution under the Bribery Act 2010.
